Families with more than one child at school are only required to provide one plate of whichever category they would like to choose.

If you are able to assist in setting up, serving or packing up, please contact the office or volunteer on the day. A form will be sent tomorrow for you to complete.

### 2023 St Angela's Years 2 - 5 - Swimming Carnival Monday 27th November

All students in Years 2-5 attend the swimming carnival and are required to complete the permission form (included in note) regardless if they are registering to swim or not. This form is also your child's swimming event registration. If your child is in the current year 1 cohort and would like to enter a <u>50m COMPETITIVE</u> <u>event</u> they must be turning 8 in 2024 to be eligible to attend the carnival. ## STUDENT ILLNESS OR INJURY

If your child has been injured and requires assistance to move around the school, parents are asked to advise Mrs Nettleton, prior to them returning to school.

Parents are required to get a doctor's letter that outlines the student's injury and that the student is able to return to school.

The treating doctor should also indicate any restrictions that need to be considered on the child's return to school.



Children who carry an injury and are required to wear a Post Surgery Boot, use crutches or operate a wheelchair must have their safety reviewed whilst onsite. It is important that we provide a safe and supportive
