## PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Over the last two weeks our Year 5 students have been considering their call to leadership for 2024. While each of the students at St Angela's is called to leadership and the service of others, each year our Year 6 students have a particular responsibility to be positive role models for the younger students by demonstrating the ability to "Let their Light Shine" and our School Values - Respect, Honesty, Tolerance, Forgiveness, Care and Compassion. As a Catholic community we have a wonderful role model for leadership in Jesus. His life provides an example of how to live and interact within our school community, our families and the wider world. Student leadership therefore needs to be seen as an opportunity for our young people to use their gifts and talents for the service of the community.

They both will be greatly missed by students and staff however we wish them every success at their new schools and thank them for their outstanding contribution to St Angela's.

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#### Online safety advice for Parents and Carers

Increasingly children are being given access to social media platforms such as Snapchat, Instagram and TikTok without a clear understanding of the potential risks that such platforms pose for young children's safety. It is important that parents are aware that each of these platforms are restricted to users over the age of 13. Therefore if you are allowing your child to use these platforms you need to be thoroughly informed about their potential to cause harm and put your child at risk.

Our school resource <u>School TV</u> provides valuable information for parents about social media in their <u>Parent and Social Media Starter Kilt</u>. This kit includes advice on what to consider when children are creating social media accounts, potential challenges relating to certain features on social media, as well as tips and advice for ongoing social media use to prevent online child sexual exploitation.

The esafety commission also has published on its website an <u>Online</u> safety Book for Parents and Carers

This book covers some of the key online safety issues for young people and includes a range of practical tips and advice on what to do if things go wrong.
