Grade Virtual Information Sessions

On Tuesday all families received a copy of the Virtual Grade Presentations for the grades relevant to their children. On your behalf many thanks to all the teachers for their time in preparing these presentations and their commitment to working with you. Together we know that working in partnership truly benefits your child's learning.

Getting to Know Your Child At St Angela's,

Assessment of the children's learning plays an important role in ensuring that teaching is matched to the children's learning needs. When assessing, the teachers collect, analyse and record information about the children's progress in their learning. While assessment occurs across all grades throughout the year, we place a particular focus on the early years of their formal schooling. Over the first few weeks of this term, teachers have been assessing the children's literacy and numeracy abilities. Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 children also complete the Literacy Early Years Assessment (EYA) and the Mathematics Assessment Interview (MAI). Additionally, Years 2-6 along with other literacy assessments complete an MAI focused on Place Value as well as teacher designed assessments. All of these assessments allow the teachers to individually assess each child, learn about how they think, and to find out what they know and can do in literacy and numeracy. The information gathered from these assessments assists the children's teachers to plan learning experiences that best support the children's abilities and needs. So that the children's growth in their learning can be measured and monitored, many of these assessments will be administered again at the end of the school year.

Meet the Teacher Interviews

Teachers have commenced their Parent Teacher interviews. Thank you to all of our parents for giving so generously of your time to meet with your children's teachers. It is wonderful to see the teachers and parents working in true partnership with the children as the priority. These interviews will continue next week as well.



5-7 years - Net Set Go Skills


Our Net Set Go skills program is perfect for beginners wanting to learn basic netbal skills. Sessions are held at Bernie Mullane on Monday nights.
