2. Principals are to:
 - 2.1. ensure that there is evidence of Aboriginal cross-curriculum perspectives in teachers' programs
 - 2.2. evidence the implementation of programs aimed to improve the educational outcomes for Aboriginal students enrolled in CEDP schools.
3. At enrolment principals are to inform the parents of Aboriginal students of their eligibility to apply for the Bishop Manning Scholarship Fund and/or the School Fee Co-Contribution Scheme - Welcoming Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students into Catholic Schools also known as [Byallawa](#).

Definitions

Where the context requires the use of the term 'Indigenous', 'Aboriginal' is used to mean Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people.
