

School Fees

School fee accounts for 2020 will be mailed out by the Catholic Education Office by Thursday 20^{th} February. As in the past, families will be given a choice to either pay their account under the current school fee payment terms of 30 days or by weekly, fortnightly or monthly instalments over a 6 month period from March to August. This payment arrangement is known as a flexible payment plan (FPP). To make FPP payments families will complete and lodge a direct debit authority with the Catholic Education Office. There is no additional administration fees to families accepting the FPP offer, however if a payment rejects fees may be incurred and if a payment rejects twice it is automatically cancelled. Alternatively, accounts may also be paid via BPay allowing parents to set up their own periodic payment and select a period (eg. Monthly) to pay their fees by instalments. There is no cost to parents using BPay. At the school office, accounts can be paid by cheque and Eftpos. Detailed information regarding FPP along with the appropriate application forms will be included with your school fee account. As per last year we have also included the majority of school based fees for 2020 into the annual account so that these costs are incorporated into FPP arrangements. Term 1 fees, unless undertaking a FPP arrangement, are due on 18th March 2020. Please refer to the 2020 School Fees information emailed today.

How do I update my child's absence on the Parent Portal?

To our new families and as a reminder to our current families, listed below is a brief outline of how to use our Parent Portal to update your child's absence from school.

Families who were here in 2019 will also have access to the Parent Portal using a login. New families will receive their login information from the Catholic Education Department Parramatta later this term.

Please ensure you complete all of the details mentioned above, monitoring student absence is a mandatory requirement for all schools and allows us support our St Angela's Community.

Additionally, school requires an <u>Application for Extended Leave - Travel (3 or more days)</u> if your family has no alternative but to travel throughout the school term.

If a student is absent from school for an extended or regular period of time an <u>Application for Exemption from</u> <u>Attendance at School</u> is required. Some examples of this include if your child participates in; eilite arts/sporting events (eg National or State level) is employed in the entertainment industry or is absent for exceptional circumstances (eg medical condition that requires ongoing treatment). If you need further clarification please email or phone the office on 9407 6400.

These applications need to be submitted to the Principal well in advance of their starting date. Applications are reviewed by the Principal and if granted, a Certificate of Exemption or a Certificate of Extended Leave Travel – 3 or more days will be issued.

Class Parent Representatives



Have You Returned Your Medication Forms and Action Plan?

Thank you to those parents who have returned forms and action plans for children who have medication stored or administered at school due to anaphylaxis, allergies or asthma. If you have not updated your paperwork, could you please do so <u>as a matter of importance</u>. If you require forms to be resent, please contact the school office. If your child no longer requires medication to be stored at school, please email stangelas@parra.catholic.edu.au and we will remove your child's name from our records. It is essential that these forms and action plans are updated annually by your child's doctor so that our records are accurate and reflect the needs of each individual child. As noted, it is the responsibility of parents to ensure that their child's medication remains current, ie. not expired. Please note this in a diary or on your phone. Thank you for your attention to this important matter.
