## PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

This week is recognised as National Reconciliation Week, a time for all Australians to learn about our shared histories, cultures, and achievements, and to explore how each of us can contribute to achieving reconciliation in Australia Reconciliation. The dates for NRW are the same each year; 27 May to 3 June.

These dates of National Reconciliation Week commemorate two significant milestones in the reconciliation journey— the successful 1967 referendum, and the High Court Mabo decision respectively.

**27 May 1967** On this day, Australia's most successful referendum saw more than 90 per cent of Australians vote to give the Australian Government power to make laws for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and recognise them in the Census.

**3 June 1992** On this day, the Australian High Court delivered the Mabo decision, the culmination of Eddie Koiki Mabo's challenge to the legal fiction of 'terra nullius' (land belonging to no one) and leading to the legal recognition of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples as the Traditional Owners and Custodians of lands. This decision paved the way for Native Title.

The theme of the 2022 National Reconciliation Week "Be Brave. Make Change." asks all Australians to be brave in working towards change that benefits all Australians.

As part of its commitment to justice for Australia's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, CEDP has developed its first <u>Reconciliation Action Plan (RAP)</u>

Our vision for reconciliation seeks to support Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children and young people and their families to flourish.

The CEDP 'Reflect' RAP identifies areas for improvement across our organisation and school communities. Our RAP Committee has been working towards a vision statement and local Elders have already provided feedback on this. Ongoing dialogue with Elders will continue to support the implementation of the RAP.

Today and tomorrow I will be in Canberra with Year 6. Mrs Yager will be at he AP's Conference at Baulkham Hills. Mrs Jocelyn Williams (REC) will be available should you need support.

#### COVID

Families at St Angela's continue to experience COVID cases, so it is important for you to monitor your children for symptoms and keep them at home if they are unwell. We will also contact you if your child feels unwell at school. As it is flu season, please be vigilant about the early signs of influenza which also require you to keep your children at home to ensure that we continue to maintain a healthy environment for the children and staff while at school. ### COVID SAFE PROTOCOLS

All students, families and staff are requested to follow NSW Health's advice to reduce the risk of not only transmitting COVID-19, but also other illnesses that may affect schools this winter such as the flu. Therefore we ask that students, staff and family members who visit the school

#### Parents are required to:

- inform the school if their child tests COVID positive
- and keep the child at home in isolation for the required 7 days. inform the school if their child is a close household contact, • administer a RAT daily before the child attends school and keep the child home if they are unwell or symptomatic
