May you have the spirit of Christmas which is Peace, the gladness of Christmas which is Hope and the Heart of Christmas which is Love".









2023 Mathematical Assessment Interviews Years One - Six

In 2023 we will again commence the school year with Mathematical Assessment Interviews (MAI) for students Year 1 - Year 6. Friday 27th and Monday 30th January have been set aside for this purpose as Staff Development Days. The Mathematical Assessment Interviews enable teachers to tailor their mathematics teaching program to effectively meet the needs of their students. Being able to perform the assessment at this earlier time will mean that teachers will have valuable information about each child's learning in mathematics from the very beginning of the year. To have a large number of assessments completed before the children formally return to school will enable teachers to perform the remaining assessments in a timely fashion once the term commences and with the least disruption to class learning time. Parents are asked to use the School Interview booking system to make an appointment for your children on either Friday 27 January 2023 or Monday 30 January 2023. Families are advised that if they go online and cannot find an available appointment time with their child's teacher not to worry as those children will have their interview once they return to school in the early weeks of Term One.

On Friday 16th December families with 3 and 4 children will receive a booking code to go online to the School Interview booking site to make appointments for their children. This will allow these families to book interviews at the same time slot for their children with their teachers.

Remember these appointments are for students in Year 1 - Year 6. 2023 only. Next week Kinder 2023 families will receive separate information about their assessment interviews.

COMPASS REPORTS

Student Reports each semester can be accessed via the Compass Parent Portal. The benefit of this is that they are saved centrally for you to access at any time and you can also download and print them if you wish. Please note that once your child has left the school you will no longer have access to their school Academic Reports on Compass. Please ensure that you download your child's reports before they leave the school.

END OF YEAR REPORTS

Your child's Semester Two report will be shared with you via COMPASS on Thursday 8th December . Teachers have been busy completing assessments and writing comments over the past few weeks.

Compass App and **Compass Parent Portal**

As mentioned in previous school newsletters, St Angela's uses Compass as the primary source of communication with families. Each week all families should be receiving the school newsletter, What's on this week at St Angela's, and a variety of other communications relevant to your child and their grade via Compass notifications and email. Now is the time if you are having any difficulties accessing Compass to reach out for assistance.

All parents have access to the **Compass Parent Portal** and are able to review and update attendance and family contact details. Since 2020 parents have accessed Semester Learning Reports via the Compass Parent Portal. In Week 9 this term, parents will access their child's Semester One Learning Report on the **Compass Parent Portal**. Now is the time for you to check your access. Should you have any difficulties please contact the school via email placing "Compass Parent Portal" the subject of the email.

Semester Two Reports

Teachers are preparing Semester Two Learning Reports. These Reports highlight particular strengths, as well as areas of development for your child. The A-E style of reporting is mandated by the Government for all grades except Kindergarten (who have a different Reporting scale).

*There are no predetermined number of A, B, C, D, E achievement levels to be allocated

*Each Key Learning Area must have an overall achievement level indicated * It is important to note than this reporting process is not based on a bell curve.

*The overall achievement level is for the whole Key Learning Area (KLA) which may contain many strands. Although some KLA's have been broken into strands,

it is important to note that some strands have more weight than others. The overall achievement is not just a straight averaging of strands. *Comparative data for the grade is included in the reports for Years 1-6.

*The achievement levels / common grade scale are provided by the NSW Education Standards Authority and are included in your report for you to reference. *Each year level introduces different concepts, content units and skills etc. which can increase in difficulty from the year before. It is therefore possible that your child's achievement level in a particular Key Learning Area may change. The achievement level of 'C' is awarded to children who have achieved sound knowledge and understanding of work covered in that particular grade at this particular time. It means your child is working and achieving appropriately for their grade. This may be different from the traditional 'C' from our own school days. Our parent/teacher interviews seek to explain, elaborate on, and support the Reports. The following website https://arc.nesa.nsw.edu.au/go/k-6 provides work samples that illustrate A-E Achievement levels. It is well worth a look.
