The Orleans Way back entrance to school

This entrance is particularly busy in the mornings. Parents are asked to follow these guidelines:-

- If you are parking and escorting your children to the back gate, please
 return to your vehicle as soon as possible so that your parking space
 can be used by other parents who would also like to park and walk
 their children to the gate.
- If you know that you will be arriving at 8:30am please use the
 Harrington Rd Kiss and Drop. The gates in Orleans Way will be closed
 promptly at 8:30am so that teachers and students can make their way
 to their classes. Teachers cannot be waiting for children who arrive
 after this time.
- Please do not stand across the bottom of the driveway on the road.
 Children and parents need to be able to safely access the driveway from the flagged pedestrian zone.
- Be mindful of the parking signage and do not double park waiting for a parking space to become free - Council Rangers are patrolling this area and issuing infringement fines.

In the afternoons:

- Parents are to meet their children on the school side of the road. NEVER beckon your child across the road or to come out of the gates before the supervising teacher has dismissed them.
- Once you have met your child please move off as soon as possible to make way for other families.

SCHOOL CENSUS DAY FRIDAY 10TH FEBRUARY

Friday 10th February is the school census day. All children should attend school on this day and absence should only be if it is absolutely necessary. If you know your child will be away on Friday 10th February, please email the school advising the reason for the absence and when they will return.

This is of course a requirement that applies to everyday of the school year, however Census data is directly related to Government funding for our schools and the requirements outlined above are set by the Department of Education. Thank you for your cooperation.

NOTIFICATION POLICY IF MOVING FROM ST **ANGELA'S**

If you are leaving St Angela's please ensure you are aware that the Diocese requests a full terms notice, (10 school weeks) in writing, to be given to the Principal before a parent/guardian terminates a students enrolment. According to Diocesan policy, if the required notice is not given, the parent/guardian is to pay one term's school fees including diocesan fees.

Upon withdrawal of a student, fees are calculated on a pro-rata basis according to the notification period given.

One exception is that notice in writing, will be accepted at anytime during Term 4.

This is outlined on the last page of your Term 1 school fee account statement and also on the enrolment formore instructions.
