Celebrating our school expectation of living Responsibly.

This week as a whole school we having had a focus on our school expectation of Living Responsibly by putting our rubbish in the bin.

4 Blue really felt that we could encourage everyone in our school community to do this by creating posters on Canva to be displayed around the school. They also included a QR code that is linked to a video so that students in Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 could learn more about what the impacts of not looking after God's World would be and how they too can help make a change.



Technology Policy— Student Agreement

At St Angela's students learn using a range of learning tools and devices. Your child will have access to a device - either a Chromebook (Years 2 to 6) or an iPad (Kindy/Year 1) to use at school for learning. From the beginning of the year, teachers have begun teaching the expectations of care and safety when using the device and key messages about their parrastu accounts when used at school and home in line with the Student Use of Digital Devices and Online Services Policy.

Each student at St Angela's is allocated a unique username and password, which is to be used for learning at school and at home. The students will use this account to complete tasks on Google Classroom, flipgrid, Canva and many other learning apps/sites that we introduce them to. For your child's protection, this account is owned and managed by CSPD to ensure their online safety and protection when learning. At times, students are encouraged to continue their learning at home and complete tasks assigned by their classroom teachers using their parrastu account.

Today we are sending home a copy of the Student Agreement, taken from the Student Use of Digital Devices and Online Services Policy. Please read the policy and sign and return the agreement to your child's class teacher.
