#### Safety at the Back Gate

In Orleans Way, please <u>do not pull up to the bottom of the</u> <u>driveway</u> to let your child/ren out in the morning or pick them up in the afternoon. This is dangerous particularly if you then reverse your car to re enter the road

New Council signage has been installed in Orleans Way 'No Stopping 8.00-9.30am and 2.30-4.00pm school days' adding to the existing fulltime 'No Stopping' restrictions on the southern side of the school driveway for an additional 10 metres. Please be mindful that this will be monitored by the council and Police.

Having these spaces clear at all times for students will make the back gate area much safer for pedestrian access. If you would like to drop your children off by car the Kiss n Drop accessed via Harrington Avenue is the safest option.

To access the Compass Parent Portal app, simply download the 'Compass School Manager' app, available through Apple Store or Google Play. It is suitable for both iPhone and Android Smartphones.



**QKR!** (pronounced 'quicker') Mobile Payment App - St Angela's is a 'cashless school'. QKR! is an easy to use mobile phone application that is also suitable for both iPhone and Android Smartphones. This service is currently available for all payments except for school fees. Communications will be distributed as new events and products become available for purchase.

It's <u>National Child Protection Week</u>, and this year's theme, "Every Conversation Matters", is a timely reminder of how powerful everyday chats with children can be – especially when it comes to their online lives.

The online world offers incredible opportunities but also has its share of risks we need to educate children about. Think of it like teaching a child to ride a bike. You wouldn't send them off without practice or a helmet. The same goes for the online world – we need to ensure children are prepared and protected before they start navigating it on their own.

A growing concern in Australia and around the world is <u>child sexual abuse online</u>. It's a tough topic, but it's one we need to address head-on. This issue is affecting children of all ages, showing up in different ways like non-consensual sharing of intimate images, techfacilitated child sexual abuse, sexual extortion and the grooming of a child with the intention to abuse them online or in person.

With 11% of teens aged 14-17 reporting they've been solicited sexually online, it's more important than ever to create environments where children feel safe to speak up – whether they're at home or school.

**So, what can you do?** The good news is that as parents, carers and educators, you can take practical steps to make a real difference. Our research shows that when we strengthen the support systems around children, we give them the best chance to stay safe online.

To help you get started, in this edition you'll find:

- <u>New resources</u> for parents and carers to help protect children from sexual abuse online
- <u>Virtual classroom webinars</u> for students
- Our new parent campaign
- <u>How we're holding social media giants accountable</u> to protect children online.

Together, we can ensure children have the support they need to explore the online world safely. Let's make every conversation count this National Child Protection

week – and beyond
